3	Since ninety-three, a local's delight; With groceries and goods, morning to night. For lottery dreams or a spirited cheer; Find what you need, year after year. Look for a legend, tall and quite grand, Larry Bird's watching, taking a stand!	Sticker
4	I'm new in the town, actually just being built. You can stop by and play on me any day any time. What and where am I?	Written answer
5	Calling all newbies with sneakers or boots, - We've got a wild mission that surely suits! The Library's calling and Hager Park, too. With poker chips hidden and clues just for you! First stop: a lot where Route 140 hums, East side, parked cars, trail map thumbs. Scan for the route—it's digital delight, and follow the diamonds into foresty night.
